# Role Title: Piano Teacher (Part-Time)

We are looking for an inspirational and highly motivated piano teacher to join our team and work with children aged 6 years and upwards teaching individual piano lessons. There is also the potential to teach other instruments and a group ukulele class, again for children aged 6 and upwards.

The children you would be teaching attend Vivace's group musicianship classes, in which they will have acquired a good ear, sense of beat, rhythm and tuning and an understanding of how music notation works. Vivace's group classes are designed to continue to run alongside instrumental tuition, strengthening children's aural and theoretical skills in very practical ways and setting children up for success from the start.

The children you would teach as beginners will already

- Love music and understand that music is a magical world that they can explore and shape
- Be confident singers
- Have a steady beat and understand the difference between beat and rhythm
- Know at least crotchets, quavers, rests and minims and be able to sight-read and notate these
- Understand pitch from a solfa-perspective, having covered most of the pentatone, if not more (relative solfa is a powerful tool for sight-singing, which helps lay early foundations for understanding key signatures logically rather than by rote), and be able to sight-sing
- Have a useful repertoire of simple songs useful for developing by-ear-playing, exploration of the whole keyboard (rather than Middle C position) and much more
- Have learned music skills easily compatible with piano teaching systems such as Dogs & Birds, Ready to Play, Piano Safari and others

If you love working with children, have relevant experience teaching piano, are attracted to working with children who already have a solid musical foundation and are looking for a part-time position in a dynamic, growing organisation, this could be the perfect opportunity for you.
